

# Pixel Developer Mode



# Designed for developers

Developer Mode offers additional flexibility to create custom event rules and enrich conversion data via parameter inputs.

## Customize event rules

---

Code, create and configure pixel event rules with purpose-built flexibility.

Custom event rules let advertisers control how and when events are triggered, like scrolling down a page or completing a set of actions.

## Add parameters

---

Activate audiences and enrich reporting with data-driven visitor insights.

Parameters enable ambitious advertisers to send additional information about website visitor events, like product purchased or price paid.



# Requirements

Developer Mode requires knowledge of how to implement and customize Javascript code. In order to add the pixel to a website or tag manager, developers will need:

- Access to the advertiser website source code
- Access to the advertiser TikTok Ads Manager Account
- Pixel base code found in Events Manager

# Get started

After creating a new pixel in Events Manager, select 'Developer Mode.'

Copy the pixel base code and add it to your website.

Add pixel event code by referencing the developer documentation.

Verify pixel installation with Pixel Status, Test Events and the Pixel Helper Chrome extension.

**Standard Mode**

Set the event rules on Event Manager. You will install the base code on your website.

Set the event rules by using code. This mode supports parameters such as content\_id and value. You will install both the base code and event code on your website.
